What is IBM Lotus Sametime?

- § An IBM offering designed to help organizations succeed in today's evolving business environment
- § A platform which accelerates employee performance
 - § and help companies, communities and teams work securely, faster, at greater efficiency, at lower costs, and without getting in the way of the business
- § Built for business
- § Based on three concepts:

- ü Awareness
- ü Conversation
- ü Web Conferences

Implement Presence Awareness by...

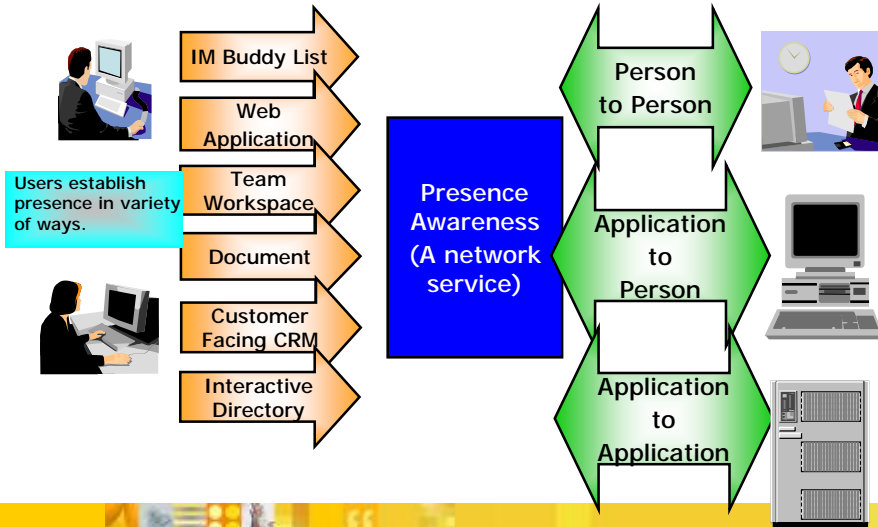
"Out of the box"

- § Presence Awareness comes built-in to many applications
 - § Such as: QuickPlace 3, Notes 6, WebSphere Portal, Live Virtual Classroom, WebSphere Commerce Business Edition, many other 3rd-party applications

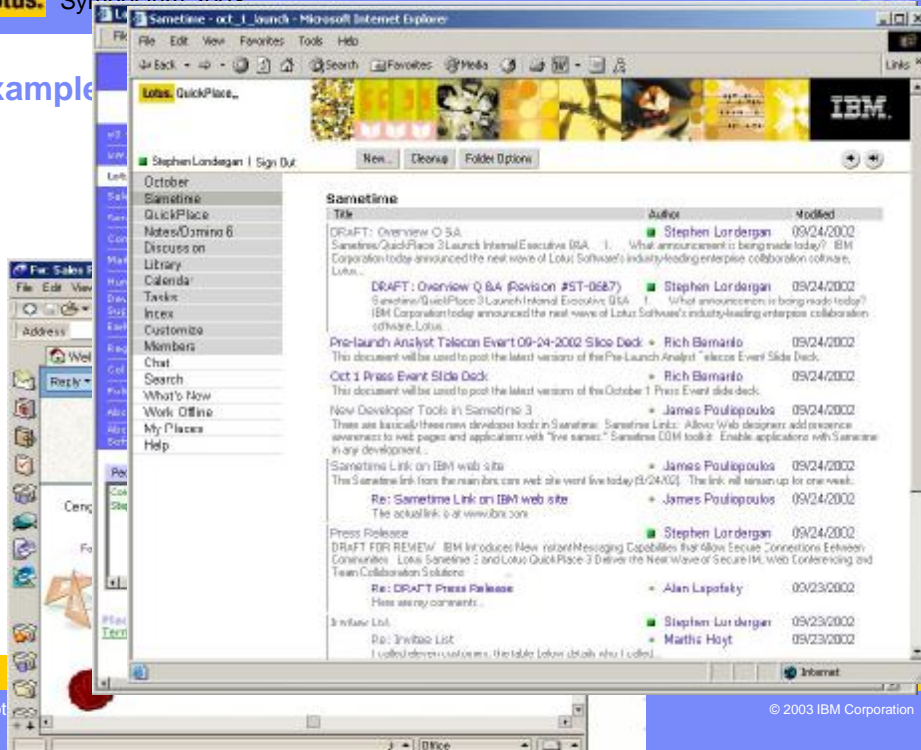
Building and customizing it

- § Presence Awareness can be brought to bear on any application
 - § Such as: portals, Microsoft Office applications, Customer service via Internet, etc.

Presence Awareness Embedded in the Infrastructure



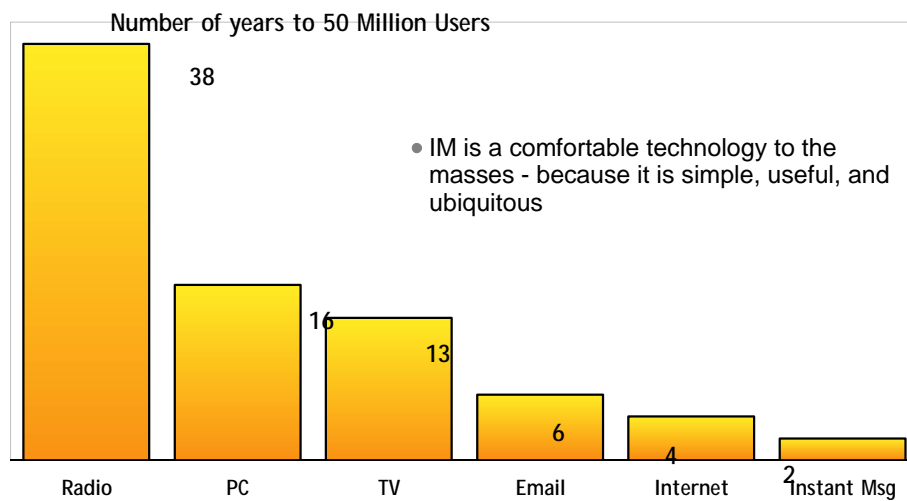

Why does Presence/Awareness matter?

- ü Value: knowing the person you need to reach is actually there
- ü Value: community automatically forms based on who is with you in a virtual place
- ü Value: Work with people across the ocean as if they're down the hall
- ü Accelerate: optimize processes; applications can find the right person to act on an approval or take appropriate action

Rapid Adoption of Instant Messaging

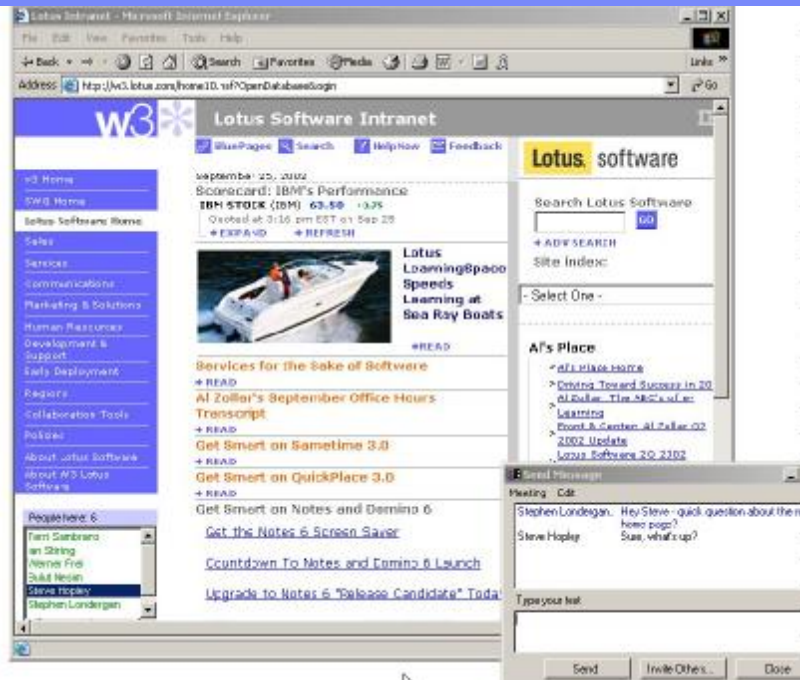


Example: Person-to-person conversation From a contact list or from any other application...

Person to application conversation

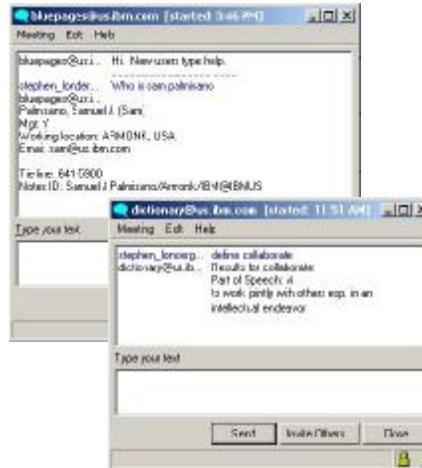

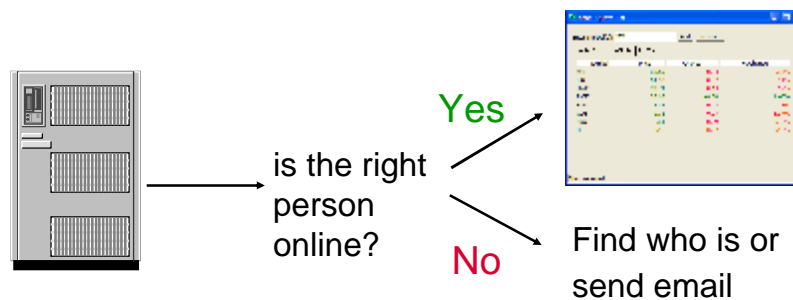


Application to Person Conversation

§ Applications initiate messages that go to online users

§ Workflows can be routed to online users to avoid bottlenecks

§ Smart notifications rely on presence awareness as their foundation



Applications use presence to find the right person and

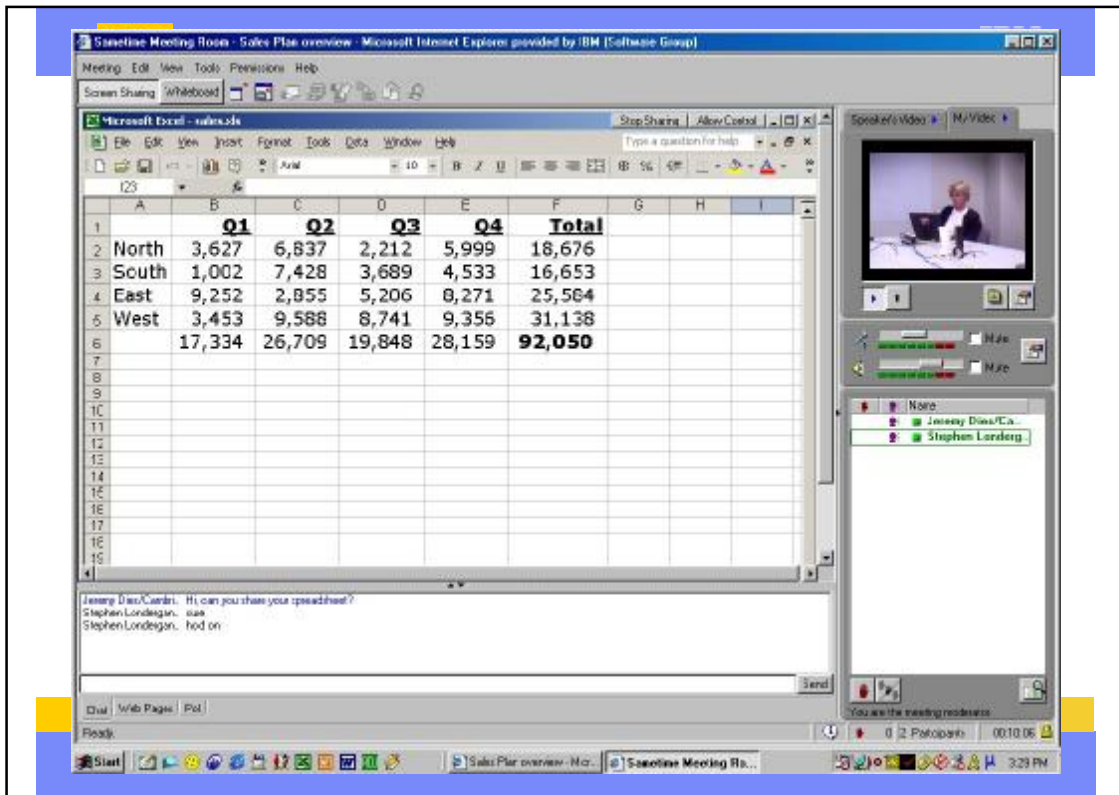
keep mission critical processes flowing

Why does Conversation matter?

- ü Accelerate: get answers faster & solve problems quicker
- ü Accelerate: assemble & lead teams more effectively
- ü Accelerate: break through the firewall and trivialize geographical boundaries
- ü Strengthen relationships
 - § B2C: Provide live, one-on-one customer service
 - § E2E: Continual, efficient collaboration throughout the work day
 - § B2E: Alerts, instant notifications, notifications

Concept #3: Web Conferencing

- § Real-time sharing of documents, files, and applications
- § Shared Whiteboard
- § Appropriate for...
 - § Giving presentations
 - § Online collaboration
 - § Letting the other person drive: local applications can be remotely controlled
- § Different types of Web conferences for different purposes
 - § Collaboration meetings for smaller groups working on something
 - § Moderated Presentation or Demo meetings for demonstrating products or presenting to larger groups
 - § Broadcast meetings for few-to-many, large broadcasts



Why does Web Conferencing matter?

§ Bring together dispersed team members to work on documents, spreadsheets, etc

- ü No travel cost incurred
- ü No lost productivity due to travel time
- ü Draw in experts only when their expertise is required

§ Seamlessly move from real-time synchronous communication interaction to asynchronous team workspace environment and back again

- § Example: Begin with a chat between two end users, launch an online meeting, solve a problem collaboratively, store the documents and team's decisions in a shared workspace, reconvene at a future date to review progress on action items

What is IBM Lotus QuickPlace?

§An IBM offering designed to help a team, or teams, succeed in today's ever-changing business environment.

§Lotus QuickPlace

- §Is a business-ready self-service Web tool specially designed for team collaboration;
- §Enables instant user-based creation of a secure workspace(s) on the Web;
- §Also, is a platform enabling "deep customization" for "horizontal" (industry and specific business process) application;
- §Integrates with Lotus Sametime's presence awareness, instant messaging and Web conferencing capabilities;
- §And integrates with Lotus Notes & Microsoft Outlook e-mail and calendar;
- §Is structured for immediate participation within and/or beyond Enterprises.

§Lotus QuickPlace is built for business



Team-based vs. Enterprise-based Solutions

§ Lotus QuickPlace, for example, is:

- § Mission critical to the team (or "vertical")
- § Largely owned and managed by the Team
- § Requires minimal infrastructure and IT support
- § User-initiated
- § Browser-based
- § Used for defined/finite periods of time
- § Focus on ROI
- § Number of users/participants typically ranges from as few as five to as many as a couple hundred
- § Usage is measured in days, weeks and months

§ Messaging, ERP & HR Mgt. Systems, for example, are:

- § Mission critical to the organization (or "horizontal")
- § Largely owned and managed by IT
- § Requires maximum infrastructure and varying levels of IT support
- § IT-initiated
- § Client/Server- and Browser-based
- § Used for an "infinite" period of time
- § Focus on reduced TCO
- § Number of users typically ranges from thousands to hundreds of thousands
- § Usage is measured in months, a year and years

QuickPlace Features - Overview

- § Integrated with synchronous tools and messaging
 - § Presence awareness & instant messaging
 - § Integration with Notes & Outlook

 - § Match your current application or intranet look & feel
 - § Create customized workspaces for specific tasks

Using QuickPlace

- §Team member creates an online "Place" for the team to collaborate
- §Manager adds members
 - §Readers, Authors, Managers
- §Basic Place elements
 - §Discussion area
 - §Document Library
 - §Team calendar
 - §Task management utility
- §Customize
 - §Use "Themes" to change the look and feel of the Place
 - §Use "PlaceTypes" to reuse content, structure, processes from previous Places
 - §Add "Rooms" as required

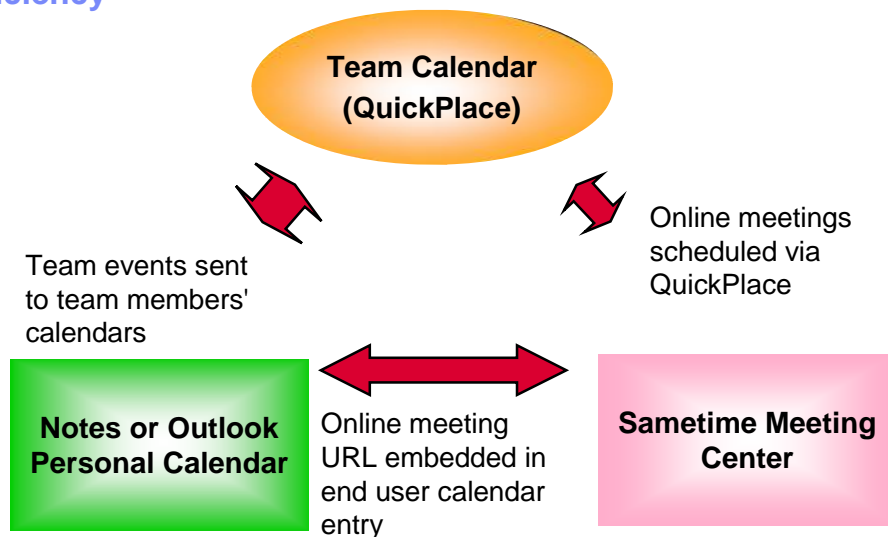
My Places - New for QuickPlace 3

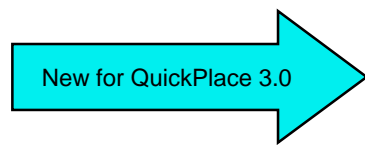

- §Low overhead - no "client", no desktop software to install
- §End users can be self-sufficient
- §Integrates with corporate directory



- §Native directory names
- §Place Catalog & QP Services
- §QPTool - replaces Admin Utility
- §Clustering
